1. The purpose of this Software User's Agreement (SUA) is to agree to procedures for use by the U. S. Army Space and Missile Defense Command/Army Forces Strategic Command (USASMDC/ARSTRAT), Future Warfare Center, Modeling and Simulation Division (MSD), hereafter referred to as MSD, and the above named organization, hereafter the User, for access to and use of a certain computer code known as the Extended Air Defense Simulation, hereafter EADSIM, in performance of the following tasks:

2. The MSD shall provide EADSIM to the User for the performance of the specific tasks described above.

3. The EADSIM furnished to the User consists of:
 - Two single DVD's containing the EADSIM executable code and documentation. Requests for source information package should be made to William Jordan at william.e.jordan44.civ@mail.mil.
4. The User agrees to accept the EADSIM subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - a. The User shall properly safeguard, maintain, and use the EADSIM, solely for the performance of the tasks described above.
 - b. The User shall limit access to EADSIM, allowing only persons actively engaged in performance of the tasks described above to use EADSIM. Since the EADSIM is under the "export control" provisions and restrictions described in Department of Defense (DOD) Directive 5230.24, Distribution Statements on Technical Documents, DOD Directive 5230.25, Withholding of Unclassified Technical Data from Public Disclosure, and DOD 5230.25 PH, Control of Unclassified Data with Military or Space Application, the User shall abide by all regulations and restrictions governing data under such control. The User shall not allow foreign nationals, including contractors, to have access to EADSIM.
 - c. The High Level Architecture (HLA) Run Time Interface (RTI) software, developed by the U.S. Department of Defense, is provided on the EADSIM DVD. The User agrees not to make further distributions of the RTI. Distribution may not be made to countries or individuals from countries on the US State Department Embargoed Nations list.
 - d. User may reproduce, for the sole purpose of reasonable backup procedures, one copy (each) of EADSIM plus any scenario(s) and data. The User may also reproduce two copies of the EADSIM documentation. The User shall return all EADSIM, data, scenario(s), backups, and documentation to the EADSIM MSD upon expiration of the term specified in this agreement. With the MSD's written permission, the User may destroy EADSIM and all associated material provided or generated, backups, and copies, with a certificate provided to the MSD verifying such destruction, in lieu of returning those items.
 - e. The User is encouraged to participate in the EADSIM Users Group meetings. The User is encouraged to furnish recommendations regarding the future development and use of EADSIM.
 - f. The User shall abide by all configuration control procedures established by the MSD.
5. This SUA shall become effective upon signature of both parties. The parties agree that EADSIM furnished to the User shall be governed by the SUA. The SUA shall remain effective until the completion of the tasks described in paragraph 1 above, unless earlier revoked in writing by either party, at which time EADSIM shall be returned to the EADSIM MSD or destroyed in accordance with paragraph 4c above.
6. The MSD reserves the right to recall all EADSIM code and documentation if the User has violated the terms of this SUA.
